Nomination Process

Program information will be sent electronically to membership. Managers that meet the criteria set forth for the award may be nominated by a peer.

Nominator must submit a letter of recommendation for the nominee by the established due date. Letter of recommendation should highlight how the nominee has achieved and met some of the listed criteria as well as their unique contributions to the industry and the association.

The nomination and voting process will be kept confidential. Committee members may not discuss the nominations and results with anyone outside of the committee until confirmation of recipients has been determined and announced.

Deadline for nominations is August 31st
